Large Scale Railroading has existed for many, many years, originating in England, and arriving in the United States in the 1940's. By the 1960's, the German toy company Lehmann Gross Bahn (Lehmann Large Trains) introduced the first Large Scale trains designed for outdoor use. LGB remains the best known of Large Scale train builders, but now there are dozens of manufacturers of Large Scale trains, both vintage and modern, standard and narrow gauge. Rugged enough for outdoors, these trains have made Large Scale the fastest growing segment of the model train hobby. The Large Scale hobby has much to offer dependable, rugged, and detailed locomotives and cars, buildings, cars, etc. to populate large and small Garden Railwavs.
